Alex Senkevitch has his line back to at least John Jamison (m. Mary Polly Shryock). Another tree on Ancestry gives the previous two generations in red, putting this line in Roxburghshire, Scotland. Could this be where all of our lines connect back to? Did some go to Ireland before moving on to America or Canada? My William Jameson is as far back as I have. YDNA has proven that our line **does not** come from James & Janet Jameson of Lancaster Co., PA. Perhaps William came from Scotland. Many think his birth year was about 1690/97. There is a baptismal in the records of Roxburghshire, Scotland for a William Jameson in 1690. More research needs to be done on all of these family lines to find the connections.

Dan Jameyson has always been under the assumption that his Samuel Jameyson line came out of Scotland, directly to Canada. Perhaps as Covenanters, those who signed the National Covenant in 1638 to show their opposition to the interference of the Stuart kings into the Presbyterian Church of Scotland. Many of these were thrown in prison, or deported to Ireland and beyond. Between this time and 1688, when William of Orange came to invade Great Britain, much of this occurred. I can tell you that my William was a presbyterian. So perhaps this is how the family ended up immigrating? Is this how Samuel Jameyson ended up in Ontario, Canada? Jane Millar, also of this line, brings up a point that he may have been in PA first, and then during the Rev War or before, having loyalist views, went to Canada. Or maybe just went directly to Canada from Ire or Scot. She believes her g grandmother, Sarah Jameson Blake may have been cousin to a David Jameson, shoemaker, of Williamsport, Lycoming, PA. Her grandfather, from New Brunswick, Canada came to stay with David Jameson about 1885. Samuel is her 5th g grandfather.

This John Jamison and 2nd wife Rhoda appear in land records in 1783, Botetourt Co., VA. He migrated to the Fayette Co., KY/Lincoln Co., KY areas, married his second wife, Mrs. Rhoda Cook Bohannon (widow of Joshua Bohannon) in Lincoln Co., KY on 10 Oct. 1781. My Robert Jamison married his wife, Isabelle Mahan in Lincoln Co., KY on 10 Jan 1785, so was in the same area. My Robert was in what became Madison Co., KY, while this John ended up in the Woodford Co., KY area before heading to Barren Co., KY. It is unknown whom his first wife was. His second wife's mother, in her will, leaves inheritance to her grandchildren "born of her daughter Rhoda's body", and hence does not include all of the children of John Jamison. This is how we know that he had a first wife and those older children belonged to the 1st. John was in Barren Co., KY in the mid to late 1790s. By 1802 he was selling his things and moving to Wilson Co., TN. His will is proven in Maury Co., TN in 1811. I think Rhoda came back to Barren Co., KY with her son James for a time. Rhoda was the dau of William Cook and Margaret Jones. Her first husband, Joshua Bohannon died prior to 1781. The Cooks and Bohannons migrated to the Fayette Co., KY area and lived along the Elkhorn. I once saw a record for a John Jameson owning a tavern on the Elkhorn. Not sure which John Jameson that was. This John can't be a brother to my Robert, since Robert already had a brother John b. 1763 that was in Nelson Co., KY/Barren Co., KY. Scott Jameson, of the Jameson Perspective speculates that Robert H. Jamison and this John Jamison could be brothers, and they could've had brothers named William and Andrew as well in Logan Co., KY. The William and Andrew could just as easily have been from any one of these lines talked about on these pages. There are descendants of this John Jamison. Need a male Jamison to YDNA test.

Could John and possibly brother William (m. Margaret Martin?) be nephews to Wm. & Sarah of Augusta Co., VA? Who is their father?

Jonathan/John Jameson m. Jean/Jane Erwin and lived in Augusta Co., VA. John's will gives 9 children as heirs, but does not name them. I and my siblings have autosomal DNA matches to many from this line. It is my thought that this John Jameson may be a nephew to William Jameson (m. Sarah) of the Calfpasture River, near Goshen, Rockbridge Co., VA. I think it possible that this John, maybe the Thomas Jameson of Adams Co., PA (m. Jane Irwin, and father of the Mary Jameson who was kidnapped and ended up with the Seneca), Robert Jamison (m. Sarah McKee), and William Jameson (m. Margaret Martin?) are brothers and nephews to William (m. Sarah), but this is not anything proven at all. Just me thinking out loud. Attached is his tree. Many people mistakenly put this John Jameson down as William (m. Sarah)'s oldest son John, but he was not. Their oldest son John was married to a Mary, not a Jean/Jane. YDNA is needed from these lines. I do match to many of this John's descendants through autosomal DNA testing. They must be related some how. Need a male Jameson to YDNA test.
