16500-1 JOHN JAMISON, died in June of 1839, in Butler co., PA. Mr. Jamison married circa 1788, Janette **Gath**. They resided in Marion, Butler co., and Westmoreland co., PA.

Notes:

If you lived in northern Butler co., PA. in the 19th century and bore the name John Jamison, you had lots of company. Five men by this name appeared on the probate records of that county from 1839 to 1873. Mr. Jamison was from Westmoreland co., PA., possibly a native of that area and settled in Marion some time before 1800. He died intestate and Letters of Administration were granted June 25, 1839, Butler co., PA. to his son, John Jamison Jr. He was a Revolutionary soldier during the War enlisting at Hannastown, Westmoreland co., PA. signing on with Colonel **McCory**'s 8th Pennsylvanian Regiment. He was discharged in Pittsburgh in 1777. He removed to Butler co., PA. and resided in Parker for a time as do some of his descendants.

Little in the way of his parentage has been discerned, though three Jamison families resided at one time in Westmoreland co., PA. Those of Greenburgh, of Salem, and of Ligonier's townships are the most likely places to start.


