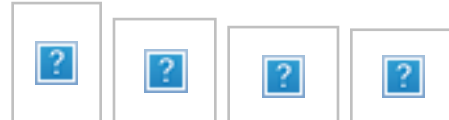

17500-1 JOHN S. JAMISON, was born March 22, 1785, prob. in PA. He died March 25, 1869, Butler co., PA. Mr. Jamison married June 11, 1811 {April 10, 1810}, Centre co., PA., Mary **Kuhn** {**Koone**}, born April 20, 1788, PA., died December 1869, Butler co., PA., the daughter of Henrick Kuhn {Coons, Koone}. They resided in Huntingdon and Butler cos., PA.

Notes:

His parents and native origins are unknown at present though he migrated from Huntingdon co., PA. to Butler co., PA. in 1818 to settle in with his son, William. In a record from the Butler County History, a paragraph reads, "*Samuel **Thompson** lived a year on the farm now owned by Joseph **Sloan**. He then induced John **Sullinger** to occupy it and keep possession. Robert **Wilson** settled upon this farm. John Jamison was brought up in his family from boyhood.*" The farm was patented by William **Parker** and later owned by Samuel and William **Stewart**, from whom Jamison obtained it. He was taxed in Huntingdon co. in 1812. Mr. Jamison was a soldier in the War of 1812. He enlisted in Huntingdon county April 1, 1813 and was discharged at Erie, PA.

October 1st.⁽¹⁾ He left a will dated March 12, 1867 and probated April 19, 1869 in Allegheny, Butler co, PA. He names his wife, Mary, mentions daughters Susannah, Mildred, and Elizabeth Hilliard; sons Henry, George, Robert, Franklin, and Alexander; and grandson William John Jamison. He states,

"I will and bequeath the residence of all my estate, both personal and real, to my son William, subject to the maintenance of my son, Alexander, during his natural life."

Mr. and Mrs. Jamison were buried at East Unity Cemetery, Cherry Valley, Venango, Butler co., PA.

H. Kuhn was a Hessian soldier during the Revolution, who married a New York girl and married a second time, and a son of Hooker Kuhns of Hesse-Hanau, Germany. He was listed in 1790 in a Huntingdon co., Pa. tax record as Henry Koone. Mr. Kuhn's first child from his 2nd marriage was born in 1798. Both son, John, and daughter, Mary, were from his first marriage.

Mr. Samuel Hilliard was born April 14, 1821, PA., and died January 12, 1909, Butler co., PA. He and his wife are buried at the Presbyterian Cemetery West Sunbury, Butler Co., Pa.

Of interest is the speculation that John Jamison and Mary Kuhn were step-siblings. Her father was a widower and his mother was a widow and they apparently married. John and Mary Jamison were married by Rev. William **Stuart** in Centre co., Pa.

Miss Jamison married James **Milford**, born April 2, 1807, PA. and died January 26, 1881, Butler co., PA. They resided in Butler co., PA. and had a number of children.

Notes:

Mr. Jamison resided in Venango and Butler counties, PA. He and his wife, were both dismissed from the Scrubgrass Presbyterian Church in 1855 and 1851, respectively. Mr. Jamison enlisted with the Union Army, Company C, 134th PA. Infantry August 9, 1862. He died from chronic dysentery while engaged in the military service and was buried in Philadelphia. William John Jamison was in his grandfather's will(John Jamison) receiving \$10.00 in 1869. He served in the Union Army and died at the Soldiers & Sailors Home in Erie, PA. He was buried South Side Cemetery in Pittsburgh, PA. Mrs. Jamison was a sister of Commissioner John **Mitchell** of Butler co., PA. She died at the home of her niece, Mrs. J. D. **Jackson**, Butler, PA. Hugh Jolly, b.c. 1833, based on the 1850 Census of Pa. was a son of Isabella Jolly.

Notes:

Mr. Jamison resided most of his life in Butler co., PA. He was well known and a respected citizen of the county. He was a devoted father and husband, community-minded, and a devout Presbyterian. He was appointed an Elder in the Scrubgrass Presbyterian Church on February 23, 1865 until his death. He enlisted with the Union Army during the Civil War and taken prisoner. Mr. Jamison was afflicted with paralysis for a number years and unable to walk the last few years of his life. He died at the age of 67 years. Mr. Atwell was a Civil War Veteran and a prisoner of war for 13 months.
