18800-1 JACOB H. JAMISON, was born about 1829, PA. He died in Indiana co., PA. Mr. Jamison married 1851, PA., Mary Rebecca Greenwood **Hoover**, born circa 1831, PA.

Mr. Jamison resided in West Manchester, Indiana co., PA. The first meeting for organizing the Presbyterian Church at Smicksburg was held at the home of James H. **McComb** on the 18th of January 1853...the committee procured two lots...a frame house forty by forty-five was built according to a draft by William **Findley**. It was framed, weather boarded, and roofed by George **Condron**, seated and chaired by Jacob H. Jamison, and painted by John **McCormick**. The cost of this first church was \$1400.00. This church was organized June 9, 1854 by a committee from Blairsville Presbytery

Mr. Jamison was a veteran of the Civil War. He was in the Union Army under the 148th Pennsylvania Volunteers, Company E., mustered out September 2, 1862 under the command of Capt. John F. **Sutton**. Jamison was at the battle of Spotsylvania, May 12, 1864, wounded during the fight and had to have an arm amputated. He was discharged honorably Ocober 7, 1864.
