DAVID JAMESON OF BEAVER COUNTY, PA.

19200-1 DAVID JAMESON was born November 25, 1792, PA. His parents were both born in Ireland. He died August 25, 1884, Scotland co., MO. at the home of his daughter, Isabella Young. Mr. Jameson married in 1813, Beaver co., PA., Ann **Hook**, born 1791, Beaver co., PA., died March 26, 1869, Winchester, Van Buren co., IA., the daughter of Matthias Hook.

Notes:

Jameson might be related to a William Jameson who was listed in the 1800 and 1810 censuses for Beaver co., Pa. William Jameson's land bordered that of Matthias Hook, so a relationship could be possible. In the area, too, was Samuel Jameson. Closed to William's age along with a Matthew and Ann Jameson, an older couple. By the 1820 census, Matthew Jameson had died, and Samuel and William Jameson had migrated to Hardy, Holmes co., Ohio. It was at this time in 1820 that David Jameson resided alongside Hook's old farm in a small town then called Hookstown, named after Matthias Hook.

Mr. Jameson was a shoemaker and dealer of shoes in Winchester, Van Buren co., IA. where he migrated to in 1856. Ann Hook Jameson inherited from her father land on which she and David Jameson resided located on the Ohio River. On July 22, 1865, their son, James Jameson, sold on behalf of the family 29 acres and 60 perches of land bordering the Ohio River for \$950.00 to William **Davidson** of East Liverpool, OH. On September 24, 1867, David Jameson et al. deeded 80 acres and 88 perches from the remaining acerage in Pennsylvania to W. C. **Spencer** and James Spencer of Beaver co., PA. for \$1611.00.

When Mrs. Jamison died in 1869, Mr. Jameson resided with his daughter and son-in-law, William and Isabella Young in Scotland co., MO. where he died. Mr. William Howard was born February 1, 1825, England and died March 18, 1906, Van Buren co., IA.

Mr. Jameson removed in 1856 to settle in Van Buren co., IA. He later moved south to Summer co., KS. some time in the mid 1870's. By 1881 he was in Crawford co., KS., where he applied for a Civil War pension in that year. He was honorably discharged after six months. He later went on to established a carpentry business from which to make his living.

Miss Jameson married first, 1846, Beaver co., PA., Artemus **Laughlin**, who died in 1851 Beaver co., PA. She married second, about 1852, Beaver co., PA., William N. **Seig**, who died in 1855, Beaver co., PA. Lastly, she married in 1856, William **Young**, who died August 15, 1890 in Scotland co., MO. They resided in Van Buren co., IA. for many years.

Jesse Ray **Gibson**, whose issue was Dale Davonne Gibson who m. Wayne **Hoover**.

Miss Jameson married November 10, 1853, Beaver co., PA., Noble **Calhoun**, who died June 1, 1873 in Van Buren co., IA. the son of Benjamin F. and Barbara (**Hammond**) Calhoun. She later married John **Sens**. They resided in Van Buren co., IA.
