JOSEPH JEMISON OF NEW CASTLE COUNTY, DELAWARE

22800-1 JOSEPH JEMISON, was born circa 1720 through 1730, place unknown. He was married. He prob. died in Red Lyon Hundred, De.

(2) 22811 John, b.c. 1752-1768;

(3) 22812 Joseph, b.c. 1754-1770; d. 9/1784;

Notes:

Mr. Jemison's parentage and nationality is unknown. He resided in Red Lyon Hundred, New Castle County, Delaware as early as 1775. After Joseph's death, Mrs. Jemison returned to Ireland. Nothing else is known of his life.

22810-2 ALEXANDER JEMISON [Joseph], was born between 1750-1765, probably elsewhere. He was married and resided in Red Lyon Hundred, New Castle co., De.

Children:

(Born in Red Lyon, De.)

(1) 22820 Lewes(Lewis), b. betw. 1770-1785;

(2) 22821 Alexander Jr., b. betw. 1772-1787;

Notes:

Resided in Red Lyon Hundred, De. The 1810 census indicates 1 male 16-26; 1 male over 45; 1 female 10-16; 1 female over 45; and 6 slaves. The 1820 census shows 2 males over 45; 1 female over 45; and 9 slaves.

22811-2 JOHN JEMISON [Joseph], was born between 1752-1768, prob. somewhere other than Red Lyon Hundred. He was married and resided in Red Lyon Hundred, DE.

(Born in Red Lyon Hundred, DE.)

(1) 22830 John, b. betw. 1772-1787;

(2) 22831 Alexander, b. betw. 1774-1789;

(3) 22832 Sarah, b. betw. 1776-1791;

Notes:

Mr. Jemison also resided in Pineader Hundred, New Castle Co., DE. The 1820 census indicates 1 male under 5; 1 male 26-45; 1 female under 5; 1 female 26-45; and 2 slaves all in New Castle, New Castle county.

22812-2 JOSEPH JEMISON [Joseph], was born betw. 1754-1770, prob. somewhere other than Red Lyon Hundred, New Castle county, Delaware. Mr. Jemison died September 15, 1784 in New Castle co., Delaware. His will was probated October 15, 1784, and mentions, "Father, Joseph Jemison and my mother, now in Ireland; brother Allexander's son, Lewes Jemison; brother John Jemison's sons, John and Allexander, and daughter, Sarah; Hugh **Jeeson**, Nancy **Lachlin**, Richard **Johnston**; Executors, brothers, John and Allexander Jemison. He died in Pineader Hundred, New Castle co.

22820-3 LEWIS JEMISON [Alexander, Joseph], was born between 1765-1784, Red Lyon Hundred, New Castle co., De. the son of Alexander Jemison (20810). Mr. Jemison was married.

Notes:

According to the 1810 census the following were shown: 2 males under 10; 1 male 26-45; 1 female, 16-26; 1 female 26-45; and 5 slaves.

22821-3 ALEXANDER JEMISON [Alexander, Joseph], was born between 1765-1784, Red Lyon Hundred, New Castle co., DE. the son of Alexander Jemison (20810). Mr. Jemison was married and had children.

Notes:

The De. census recs. of 1810 indicate 1 male under 10; 1 male 16-26; 1 male over 45(his father?); 1 female, 16-26; and 2 slaves. The 1820 census shows 2 males under 5; 1 male 26-45; 1 female 5-10; and 2 slaves. His wife appears to have died just before 1820.

22900-3 JOHN JEMISON [John, Joseph], was born between 1765-1784, Red Lyon Hundred, New Castle co., De. Mr. Jemison was married and had children.

The 1820 census shows 1 male 26-45; 1 female under 5; 1 female 26-45; and 1 slave.
