Smyrna, Kent co., Delaware. He married Sarah	_·

Notes:

Rev. Jamison emigrated from Ireland and settled in Smyrna, Kent co., Delaware, poss. a relative of some of the Jamisons already living in the village. A presbyterian minister he served at Symrna from 1734 to 1743 when he died. The land on which the church was built was donated by Mr. Jamison, Minister John Caton, and Robert Bonham, elders of the congregation around Dover, De. Re, Jamison was ordained at Templepatrick Parish, 1734 in Delaware. His will was made June 9, 1743 and probated July 15, 1743 in Kent co., DE. He names his wife, Sarah, his father, John, sister Janet Graham and nephews John and Robert Graham.
