# FRANCIS JAMISON OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

**23800-1 FRANCIS JAMISON**, born 1726/28, Belfast, Ireland, the son of Scottish immigrants. He and his wife died in 1792 on a trip to see their children in Westmoreland county. Mr. Jamison married Margaret and they resided in Buckina, Antrim co., Ireland and Westmoreland co., PA.

### Notes:

The Jamisons were probably all related in some respect to each other in County Antrim, Ireland. There is circumstantial evidence that Marmaduke Jamison, see "Foreign Branches-Ireland" was a great-nephew of Francis Jamison. Mr. Jamison emigrated about 1764 to Philadelphia settling in eastern Pennsylvania before removing in 1766 to Franklin co., PA. A document exists[3] which states that "Francis Jamison, his wife, and family of four sons and three daughters had lived in the bounds of that Congregation from their infancy and that this would admit them to church privileges in any Christian society where it might please providence to call their lot. Signed, Buckina, this 17th day of July 1764 by me

John **Logan**, Moderator"

One source indicates that Francis Jamison and family resided for a time in Maryland, but this should not be confused with the Francis Jamison (see Index #20400) who emigrated to Maryland settling in Frederick county, MD in 1769 with his two sons, John W. and William Jamison. These folks removed first to Cumberland co., PA. and then went on to Indiana co., PA. the county north of Westmoreland, while our subject settled in Westmoreland county dying in Pleasant Unity. Mr. Jamison(5 d) along with his children Francis Jr.(single, 6 d), John(1 s, 6 d), Marmaduke(single, renter, 3 s), and Robert(3 s, 1 d) were listed in 1798 taxes for Unity.

He died August 24, 1825{9/2/1825}[1], Pleasant Unity, Westmoreland co., PA. Mr. Jamison married December 13, 1773, Mercerburg, PA., Mrs. Elizabeth **Gaff(Gath)**, born 1746, Northern Ireland and died 1831, Unity, PA. They resided in Pleasant Unity, PA.

#### Notes:

Mr. Jamison settled in Franklin county and moved west in 1768/69 to Westmoreland co., PA. For 56 years he farmed the rich fertile lands of Westmoreland having built his home in 1769. He volunteered into the Revolutionary War and spent time as a Ranger on the frontier with Capt. James **Clark**. Mrs. William Gaff Jamison lost her first husband just before the family arrived in Philadelphia from Ireland. Mrs. William Gaff Jamison was the daughter of Samuel and Marjery (**Carruthers**) Workmen of Westmoreland co., PA.

In his will he states, "To James Jamison adjoining land of Robert Jamison part of larger tract pantented to Robert Jamison and willed to son, James." proved October 21, 1826

**23811-2 JOHN JAMISON** [Francis], was born 1749, Buckina, County Antrim, Ireland, the son of Francis and Margaret Jamison (23800). He died 1819, Hempfield, Westmoreland co., PA. Mr. Jamison married 9/23/1773, Mercerburg, PA., Janet **Martin**, born 1753, Fulton co., PA., died February 12, 1839, Unity, PA., the daughter of John Martin. They resided in Pleasant Unity, Westmoreland co., PA. where they died.

#### Notes:

Mr. Jamison settled in Westmoreland co., PA. with his brother, Robert in 1769 each taking a patent of land of 300 acres. Janet Martin at the age of two and two of her brothers were captured by a band of Indians in 1755. They remained with them until 1763 when Col. **Boquit** defeated the tribe that held them captive at Bushy Run and they were set free from their bonds. is land was taxed in 1789 at 1 shilling 6 quid. Mr. Jamison made his will in 1819 which was probated in the same year. Hugh and James Jamison, his sons, equally divided the farm.

- Benjamin Jamison resided in Unity, PA. He owned a 90 acre farm which was, upon his death, divided among his heirs. Letters of Administration were granted Alexander **Culbertson** on May 6, 1842. bonded at \$400.00 by Hugh Jamison and Samuel R. **Ramsey**.

James Jamison, rec'd 1/3rd of his father's estate; taxed in 1838 on 90 acres; and on 96 acres; farmer and carpenter.

Miss Jamison married about 1778, Westmoreland co., Pa., James **McCartney**, born April 11, 1745, Londonderry, County Londonderry, Ireland, died 1835, Concord, Ross Co., OH., the son of Isaac McCartney, b. Glasgow, Scotland. They resided in Westmoreland co., PA, Ross co. OH., and Campbell co., KY.

## Notes:

James McCartney was a Revolutionary soldier with the 4th PA Regiment and claimed a pension. He emigrated as a young man in 1770 from Ireland and after landing in Philadelphia settled out west in

Westmoreland co., PA. He was listed in the 1786 tax list with Jonathan Begg <u>Jamison</u>. William and Robert Jamison were purchasers of several tracts of land up for sale in 1836 after Mr. McCartney's death.

**23815-2 FRANCIS JAMISON** [Francis], was born circa 1760, County Antrim, Ireland, the son of Francis and Margaret Jamison (23800). He died 1807, Franklin co., PA. Mr. Jamison married November 26, 1789, Carlisle, Franklin co., PA., Elizabeth **Gamble**. They resided in Westmoreland and in Warren, Franklin co., PA.

#### Notes:

Mr. Jamison was in the Revolution. He resided in Westmoreland co., PA. for some time but later moved east to Franklin co., PA sometime prior to 1800. Mr. and Mrs. Francis Jamison were married in Carlisle, PA. by the Rev. Robert **Davidson**, D.D. In 1789 he was taxed in Westmoreland co. at 6 quid. Letters of Administration were granted to his spouse, Elizabeth Jamison, son, Francis Jamison, yeoman, and to Christian **Stuff** on July 4, 1807. Orphans court records Michael **Cook** as guardian of John, Polly, and Elizabeth Jamison December 19, 1809 all under the age of 14 years. On Dec. 11, 1810, Martin **Wenger** became their guardian in Warren, PA. On May 14, 1811, Frederick **Shearer** of Peters township was apoointed by the court as their guardian.

Mr. Jamison married 1818, Westmoreland co., PA. Elizabeth **Lloyd**, born November 29, 1791, PA., and died

December 6, 1846, Venango co., PA. where they resided.

#### Notes:

Mr. Jamison resided for some time in Westmoreland co., PA., but removed some time after 1810 to Venango Co., PA. settling in Cherrytree township. In 1843 James and Elizabeth Jamison sold to James **Gaullaugher**, land that he inherited from his father. Additional deeds include:

sold to John Walter, 2/3/1849, in Unity, Westmoreland co.;

Sold to James Gaullaugher 4/3/1849, 100 acres for \$1000.00, being a part of a larger tract patented 6/17/1789 by his father, Robert Jamison/recorded 4/3/1843.

There are a number of deeds of his real estate transactions that span a good period of time in Westmoreland and Venango counties. His and his wife's tombstones are located in the oldest section of the Cherrytree Presbyterian Church Cemetery. Mr. Jamison enlisted into the U. S. infantry and was a veteran of the War of 1812.

Mr. Jamison was a carpenter by vocation. Thrifty and efficient and through careful real estate options Mr. Jamison managed to save up \$5000.00 by 1850. He inherited a 90 acre tract from his father, part of that which Robert Jamison had patented in 1789 for 150 acres.

# Notes:

Mr. Jamison resided on part of the old homestead he received as part of his inheritance. He was a farmer, a school teacher(c. 1820), a Whig Republican, and a school director. He was commissioned to survey and divide the township into several school districts. He aided in the construction of Fort Meigs, Ohio and served during the War of 1812. He lived on 151 acres in Unity, PA. where he died on the old homestead. His will was dated August 31, 1870 in the presence of A. C. **Kemp** and D. A. **Huffman**, and probated January 5, 1887. He mentions his wife leaving her the mansion, gardens, and orchard she dearly loved. When she dies half the estate goes to son, Joseph Jamison and the balance was divided among Margery Jamison, Amanda Jamison, and James Jamison, his other children. He mentions also Martha **Berlin**, aniece, and a nephew Joseph Jamison. The 1850 census shows two other people residing with the Jamisons: Elizabeth Jamison, b. 1789, PA. and Sarah Jamison, b. 1828, PA.

- Eli C. Jamison was a carpenter and moved west after 1847 to Arkansas.

Jamison, Maria Stouffer, Martha L. Baldwin, Margaret Troxell, and Eliza Ann Scott, each to received one share of proceeds from the sale of the homestead.





He actively helped in the establishing of the Westmoreland Agricultural Society and became its first President and Operating officer for a number of years. Looking for other possible businesses he studied and learn the coal and coke business and in 1880 associating with influential others began purchasing coal lands in the county for the next 20 years. He founded the Robert Smith Jamison Coal and Coke Company which continues to conduct business still in 1996. He was a member of the Second Reformed Church in Greensburg.

An indenture was made March 1, 1850 between Robert S. Jamison to George T. **McFarland** of Philadelphia for 89 acres adjoining land on his lot plus thoses of William Jamison, Hannah Jamison, James **Ruffner**, and Mathew McFarland.




