# ROBERT JAMISON OF PENNSYLVANIA

[24200-24499]

**24200-1 ROBERT JAMISON**, son of Pennsylvanian parents<sup>(1)</sup>, was born about 1776 in North Carolina. He died 1816, Russellville, Logan county, KY. He married 1800, Mary **McWherter**, born 1778, SC., died 1842, Salem, Washington co., IN., the daughter of Moses McWherter. They resided in Russellville, KY.

#### Notes:

Traditional history states that Robert's parents were from Pennsylvania[1], migrating to North Carolina in 1760. Another source states they were "native of North Carolina" and "descendants of Scotch Covenantors." [2]. How much truth there is of this is not known, though with the McWherters in South Carolina, it's more than possible that they and the Jamisons probably lived within miles of each. No marriage records from NC provide documentation to support the 1800 marriage nor its whereabouts. The marriage, itself, probably occurred in Kentucky, maybe Logan county, where Robert and Mary had their children.

Their stay in Russellville, Logan county, KY was nearly 20 years, scant information providing little data to determine Robert Jamison's actual arrival in Kentucky before 1801/02. As early as October 3, 1796, four years after Logan county was established from its parent, Lincoln co., a John or Jonathan \*(2) Jamison invested in 200 acres along Prewitt's Knob. From the early 1790s into the beginnings of the 19th century,

south central Kentucky experienced a mad rush for land, many of its settlers coming from Pennsylvania, Virginia, and North Carolina. A population explosion of sorts took place after the Revolutionary War, thrusting through the Cumberland Gap with people taking up abodes beyond Fayette county. Those in the War were given North Carolina grants into Tennessee and military grants in the virgin forests of Kentucky. Obviously, Robert's parents took part in the migration west and settled at Russellville some time between 1780 to 1800.

Some kinship is expressed among this Jamison family with others in the region, and can be summarized as follows. William Jamison \*(3) and his wife, Jane, were settlers of Logan co., Ky in 1800. He purchased in 1808, 400 acres in a grant "South of the Green River" situated in Barren county. His daughter, Mary Sarah Jamison married Pouncy Nuckles, or Knuckles in 1819, Christian co., KY before removing to Texas. Some of the children are similarly named. Andrew Jamison \*(4) was settled in Logan county by the time of the 1800 census as William Jamison. He, too, removed and settled in Christian co., Ky. in 1802, and later resided in Hopkins co. where he died. In 1800, Garrett Jamison \*(5) and his wife, Jane Caldwell, left Madison co., KY and by the 1800 census were settled in Barren co., KY. This family removed from Barren co., Ky about 1818 to Washington co., IN a few years before Robert Jamison's widow, Mary McWherter Jamison and her children, among whom can be found the christian name, Garrett. As did the descendants of Robert Jamison, some of Garrett Jamison's children moved off to Iowa settling in nearby counties.

#### Notes:

At the age of three Mr. Jamison's father died and he was taken by his mother in 1816 to Washington co., IN. In 1848 he and his family arrived in Monroe County, IA. near Albia where he settled down at the beginnings of the Mormon Trace, later called the California Trail. They were the first settlers in the County and here at the beginning of the Trace in 1848, Jamison developed a trading post for emigrants and travelers heading further west. With enough money now they moved to Clarke co., IA settling in on Lot #19, 160 acres of land, when Franklin became a township May 1, 1850. He was the first school Commissioner in Clake County. He was a member of the County Board of Supervisors, a township trustee, and a Whig turned conservative Republican.

#### Notes:

Mr. Jamison was educated in Decatur Co., IA. and Ann Harbor, MI. At the age of 17, he enlisted into the 6th IA infantry, serving 18 months. He fought at the Battle of Dallas, GA., was wounded there, and mustered out shortly afterwards in July of 1865, returning to Clarke co., IA. Here in Franklin he taught school for a number of years and was appointed 1869 as the Superintendent of Clarke Co. school system. In 1872 he was elected Clerk of the District and Circuit Courts of Clarke co. In 1881-84 he was employed as a cashier at the Clarke County Bank. In 1885 was appointed an agent of the American Express Company at Osceola where he remained the rest of his years. He was a Mason and in the Grand Army of the Republic, a Republican in politics.

Mr. Jamison pursued preparatory studies in Garden Grove ACademy before moving on in 1882 to attend college in Valparaseo, IN. He studied law with the Metutui Brothers in Oseola, IA and was admitted to the bar in 1890. In 1891 he was elected State Senator serving the 24th and 25th General Assemblies. In 1898 he formed a law partnership with William H. **Park** known officially as Jamison and Park. Mr. Jamison raised three foster children who grew to manhood.


