Notes:

David Jameson was no doubt born in Virginia. He may very possibly be the grandson of James Jameson, who emigrated 1680-83 from Scotland, and settled in Prince William co., VA. in the late 1600s. It is no doubt the same one who married a Sarah, possibly the one who died in 1716. When he arrived upon American shores he was greeted by Governor Culpeper, who was in office at the time, and given five guineas as a mark of Respect and Friendship. Mr. Jameson left Edinburgh, Scotland and a father who was independently wealthy

and styled as a Gentleman. Apparently that wealth spilled over to David, who, himself, was a man of considerable wealth and station, having had some education, himself.

James Jameson may have first settled in St. Paul's Parish, Stafford co., VA., a county that forms the southern border of Prince William. Upon the records of Stafford county are the following:

He may have been married to Sarah Jameson who died in 1716 and had the son, William Jameson, as listed above. David Jameson has five children he named similarly: Jane, William, James, Elizabeth, and Sarah. While this is not conclusive, itself, the close proximity of location, ages, and Christian names screams for more information.

Mr. Jameson left a will probated January 4, 1794 in Prince William co. He left his plantation to his sons, a slave each to each daughter, plus two additional plantations, furniture, stock, and slaves for his wife, Pattey Jameson, who he left as executrix. The will was witnessed by William **Monroe**, Nathaniel **Ralls**, Enoch **Reno**, George **Edwards**, and William **Ashmore**.



Benedict Jameson/Jimeson came west with his brother, Alocious Jameson around 1822 and settled on tracts in McCrackin County, Kentucky under the Jackson Purchase Grants. This land grant 1822-1858 was completely within Indian Territory, west of the Tennessee River, east of the Mississippi River, and south of the Ohio River, comprising the present counties in Kentucky: Marshall, Calloway, McCracken, Graves, Ballard, Carlisle, Hickman, Fulton. Benedict's lots were as follows:

54 acres, SE 1/4, T1, R7E, Section 14;

160 a., SW 1/4, T1, R7E, Section 6;

160 a., SE 1/4, T1, R6E, section 1;

Sometime after his first wife's death, circa 1840-1847, Mr. Jameson and family removed to Stewart Co., TN. where he met Mrs. Mary (Ross) Acree, widow of Edward C. Acree. They had one son, Edward C. Acree Jr., b.c. 1846 in Stewart co. Mr. and Mrs. Jameson had one child, Arabella, who was born in 1852.

Mr. Jameson was born in Harrison co., KY. shortly after his parents arrival after leaving Bath co., KY. His will names Joseph **Williams**, J.S. Jimeson, J. T. **Bailey**, another family relation, and Henry **Blanton**; it also names Mrs. Polly Jimeson, and F. M. Jimeson in estate inventory records at the time of the selling of some of the personal effects. The 1880 TN census indicates the following people in the family of Benedict Jimeson: Mary, age 71, b. TN, Stewart co. and son Edward C. Acree; son William D., age 46, b. TN; his sons, Robert E., age 14, b. Ark.; William D., age 12, b. Ark.; Mary T., age 8, b. Ark.; and John R., age 6, b. Ark.
