# **GARRETT JAMISON OF MADISON COUNTY, KENTUCKY**

# [45000-45399]

**45000-1 GARRETT JAMISON**, was born circa 1760-70's in Virginia, Pennsylvania, or Kentucky. He died in May of 1827 in Washington county, IN. Mr. Jamison married October 18, 1795, Madison co., KY. to Jane **Caldwell**, born circa 1769, North Carolina, died between 1860-65, Washington co., IN., the daughter of Alexander Caldwell of Rutherford co., NC. They resided in Madison co. and Barren co., Ky., and Washington co., IN.

# Notes:

Like Robert and Mary (**McWherter**) Jamison (see #24200), Garrett Jamison and his family probably came out of North Carolina about the same time. There is a need to look at the Pennsylvania branches of the Jamisons for it is to them that perhaps these two families are descended. The McWherters {McWhorters} had left their native Pennsylvania and spread south into Albemarle county, Virginia before migrating to North Carolina. The Caldwells had done the same settling into Virginia before heading further south. The Garrett name can be found in both families as well leading to some speculation and a need for more research. Alexander Caldwell may have died in Rutherford co., NC.

The 1800 KY Census lists a Garrard Jimmerson of Barren co., KY. The 1820 KY census shows (males) 3-3-1-3-0-1 (females) 2-0-0-1-0-0-7-0-0.

Jamison bought land in Barren co., Ky on February 11, 1811 from Samuel **Scott** for 118 acres for £60 on Lick branch(Fallen Timbers) of the Skagg River. This parcel was later sold to Joseph **Willis** August 1, 1816 for \$500.00. In 1817, the family pulled up stakes and crossed the Ohio River into Washington co., IN settling on section 9 about 8 miles north of Salem.

Alexander Caldwell was from Rutherford co., NC. They migrated to Barren co., KY where he probably died, for in that county Garrett Jamison appoints a lawyer, James **Smith** of Rutherford co., NC, in 1805 to obtain his wife's inheritance of her father's estate. It is stated that Caldwell was a former residence of North Carolina.

Administrator of Garrett Jamison's estate was his son, William Jamison. With William dead by 1842, the administration of William's estate was appointed to his brother James Jamison of Washington co., IN in 1842. This might mean that William was unable to handle his affairs after 1838 since the estate was not resolved until ordered on August 16, 1842. His mother received a half share while the other brothers and sisters received \$36.85 each. Robert Jamison, his brother, was provided a parcel of land<sup>(1)</sup> from this administration which he in turn resold September 8, 1843 to James Jamison of Washington co., IN, his brother. William Jamison had purchased an 80 acre lot in Johnson co., in 1825, but appears to have remained in the home of his parents in Washington county.

Mr. Jamison married April 20, 1820, Jefferson co., IN to Mary **Welch**, born July 7, 1793, daughter of Samuel and Jane (**Cunningham**)<sup>(3)</sup>. Welch.

### Notes:

Samuel Welch was in the Revolutionary War. Born November 11, 1762, and died December 30, 1842, he was probably the son of Walter Welch and Mary (**Hillis**) who emigrated from Ireland and settled in PA, IN, and later died in Virginia in 1789. Samuel resided in Shippensburg, Cumberland co., PA before coming west to Jefferson co., IN with his brother, James Welch. Welch served in the Indian Wars and later the Revolution applying for a pension later on in life. He served as a private under Capt. William Faulkner's Company, then later under General Wayne engaged later at the Battle of Miami Rapids. In 1767 he moved to Clark co., KY, but by 1816 removed to Jefferson co., IN where he operated a grist mill and dam on his farm. He died at Caledonia, Jefferson county.

Hugh Kirkwood married first on 24 Sept. 1836 in Jefferson Co., his wife's aunt, Sarah Welch, 20 Feb. 1816-15 Nov. 1847. Hugh Kirkwood lived 1816-11 Nov. 1856. He and his wife were buried Caledonia Cem. James Jameson listed 1860 Jefferson Co. census in Shelby Twp., no other record. Ann Ralston, daughter of Dr. William Ralston, an uncle of Matthew Ralston, m. 2nd David **Culbertson**. Robert, Ann and David are all buried at Caledonia Cemetery. Ann Glenn, b. 6 Feb.1840-14 Nov. 1907, and her husband are both buried Caledonia Cem. Matthew Ralston(1837-1875) and his wife are both buried Caledonia Cem. Napoleon **Etherton** m. 2nd 12/8/1861 in Jefferson Co. Lucinda **Risk**;

Mr. Jamison married February 22, 1821, Washington co., IN., Elizabeth Foster, born 1800, Albemarle co., Va., died November 8, 1850, Johnson co., IN., the daughter of William and Margaret (Buster) Foster.

### Notes:

The Jamisons came on to Washington co. IN in 1817. On July 22, 1824, he purchased 40 acres along the Blue River, Johnson co., IN the S <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of the W <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of the NE <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of section 22. He got this from his in-laws. On March 1827 he was summoned for jury duty. In 1836 Alexander went back to Barren co., KY for the funeral of a Samuel Jemison who had recently died. He had become the administrator of the estate. On 8/9/1836 he bought 80 more acres in section 27 of Hensley, Johnson county from Alexander and Chinesa **Stevens** for \$500.00, Richard **Foster**, witness. On October 3 of the same year 120 acres, section 27 from Jacob and Elizabeth **Butram** for \$500.00-same witness, Foster. May 27, 1839, security for Richard Foster when latter aministrator estate of William **Adams**, husband of Maria Foster, Richard's sister. February 3, 1841, Alexandeer Jimison, witnessed will of John **Stevens** in Hensley, IN.

On August 8, 1845 he made out his will in Hensley naming wife, Elizabeth; sons-James, Charles, and Richard; daughters-Mariah Ellen, Manda C., Louisy Lucinda, America Ann, Margaret Jane, Mary Emily and Susan Frances. Executor was Richard Foster; witnesses-Richard Hensley Sr; William. Recorded 9/13/1845 and buried at Bethlehem Cemetery, Bethlehem, IN.

Mr. Jamison was a farmer in Washington co., IN. His will was dated May 31, 1851 and proven 11/17 of that year. Garrett W. **Logan** was appointed Letters of Administration. Mrs. Jamison remarried December 2, 1865, Washington co., IN, Mathew **Masterson** {b.8/20/1812; d. 4/27/1878;}[8].

According Col. James Head in his research Mr. Judy "purchased a small skiff and they drifted down the Missouri River to Wyandotte, Kansas in 1866. Mr. Judy opened Kansas City's first transfer business and trucked buffalo meat, shipped down the Kaw river on boats."

"WILLIAM G. JAMISON, Auditor of Washington County, is a son of Joseph and Margaret (Gilchrist) Jamison, and is a native of the county in which he now resides. Joseph Jamison was born in Kentucky, January 29, 1811, a son of Garrett Jamison, who removed with his family to the Hoosier State in 1817, and where he and wife both died. Joseph and wife were the parents of William G. and Polly Ann (now Mrs. M. L. Ribelin), and they are yet living on the farm entered by Joseph's father. William G. Jamison was raised on the old homestead, but unlike his father in one respect, he secured a good practical education. He farmed and taught school for a number of years, and in 1860, was united in marriage with Margery Davis, by whom he became the father of five children named: Samuel J., now a cell guard at the State Prison; John W., a merchant at Rich Hill, Mo.; Jerry M.; Melvedia and Winfield, deceased. The mother died September 17,1880, a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church. On Christmas, 1882, Mr. Jamison married his present wife, who was Mary E. Smith.
