NOTES:

Much of the following materials and research has come to me from Mrs. Nancy (Jamerson) Weiland of Virginia. Between her and another family member researcher, they have come to recognize two distinct Jamerson or Jimerson family branches in Buckingham county, Virginia. Along with my own early research, I have included some new references to tag upon the Jamerson lineage you are about to read. (See also Gendex 49700)

JOHN JIMMERSON(JAMISON) OF BUCKINGHAM COUNTY, VIRGINIA

50200-1 JOHN JIMMERSON, b.c. 1760s, VA? Died circa 1813, Buckingham co., VA. He married 11/17/1786, Sarah **Palmer**, daughter of Mr. and Elizabeth Palmer.

Notes:

Mr. Jamison resided in Buckingham co., VA. This line resided in the Buckingham Court House and Dillwyn areas of Buckingham. William Johnson **Berryman**, was the bondsman for his marriage to Sarah. Mr. Jamison left his legatees on February 22, 1810, 157 acres along the waters of Little Buffalo Creek joining lines of Ford's Legatees, Thomas **Christian**, Carter **Adcock**, Tally **May**, and Peter **May**. A lot was allowed his widow, 50 acres; Nancy Jamison, 33 ½ acres; Daniel Jamison, 37 ½ acres, and John **Harris**, 36 acres. The 1810 Census showed 1 male, 16-26, 1 male 26-45; females, none, slaves-3. Of speculatory note the names Adcock, May, and Harris are surnames associated with the Jamisons of Albemarle co., VA. Could there be some connection? Land records include 150 acres on Buffalo Creek, his 1814 administration of deceased's estate, and an 1821 deed conveying 37 acres of the original 157 to son, Daniel.

Documents show the earlier form of the surname as Jamison and later as Jimmerson, obviously a corruption. Over the years it was finally and legally written as Jamerson and continues in that fashion today. Where the Jamersons come from originally is not actually known as yet. But with Albemarle county just to the north of

Buckingham, some researchers feel that John was a descendant of these Jamisons. There is some good reason to think this, in light of some of the family surnames such as Adcock, Harris, and Berryman who were listed as residence with the Jamisons in Albemarle county. The Jamison referred to here can be found under the index number #30400.

Notes:
Mr. Jamerson, as he later began spelling the surname, built his home on one site and moved it to another. He enlisted into Company K, 2 nd Virginia Artillery under the Confederate States of America. He was captured at Mine Run, November 30, 1863 and transferred to Point Lookout, a Union hospital, on February 3, 1864. Discharged after his release at Farmville headquarters in an old tobacco barn he returned home.
