That one would settle into the wild New England frontier and the other would pick up and leave to return to Colchester will enlighten those researchers who arguably believe them Jamesons and not otherwise in the pursuit of truth.

Generation 1

1. **SIR RALPH**¹ **JENNISON**¹⁻² was born in 1537 in Newcastle Upon Tyne, Northumberland, England¹. He married **Margaret Hunter**. She was born in 1548 in Newcastle Upon Tyne, Northumberland, England¹.

Sir Ralph Jennison and Margaret Hunter had the following child:

2. I. ROBERT² JENISON²⁻⁶ was born in 1582 in Newcastle, Shropshire, England (Born in his father's home²). He died on Nov/06/1652 in Colchester, Essex, England^{2, 4}. He married Elizabeth Favour. She was born about 1588 in England¹.

Generation 2

2. **ROBERT**² **JENISON** (Sir Ralph¹ Jennison)²⁻⁶ was born in 1582 in Newcastle, Shropshire, England (Born in his father's home²). He died on Nov/06/1652 in Colchester, Essex, England^{2, 4}. He married **Elizabeth Favour**. She was born about 1588 in England¹.

Robert Jenison and Elizabeth Favour had the following children:

i. WILLIAM³ JENISON⁷⁻¹⁵ was born in 1608 in Colchester, Essex, England^{12, 14}. He died in 1657 (Age: 48¹⁴). William Jenison⁷⁻¹⁵ arrived in Salem, Essex, Massachusetts, USA in 1629^{7, 14-15}. He departed in 1630 (Age: 21). He died in 1667 in Colchester, Essex, England¹²⁻¹³.

Notes for William Jenison:

This family from Colchester, England has always spelt the name Jenison or Jennison, however, since coming to the Colonies the surname has, as usual, seen a number of misspellings which has led to confusion to a number of

researchers. Many have incorrectly labeled them Jamison and Jameson and have added these people to their lineages failing to realize the differences this makes to their tree.

When he first chance to come over the Atlantic he appears as early as 1628 as a ship's captain and merchandiser. A few years older than his brother, Robert, William settled first in Charlestown then removed in 1630 to Watertown and admitted a Freeman in May of 1631. "August 23, 1634, Agreed by the confent of the Freemen, that there fhall be Chofen three perfons to be "indecipherable" the ordering of the civill affaires in the Towne One of them to ferve as Towne Clark, and fhall keep the Records and Acts of the Towne. The three chofen are William Jennifon, Brian Pembleton, John Eddie."(fn3,p1). As an Ensign in 1630, he was made Captain in the following year at Charlestown and appointed one of four Commissioners in 1637 to handle small judicial cases. He was granted in the Third Division, Lot #25, sixty acres of land. On February 28th he was granted an additional ten acres on Lot 37 of the Plow lands at the Beverbroke Planes by the river. Again, June 26thm 1637 a grant of ten acres was provided him at the Remote or Westpine Meadows Lot #6. He was a member of the Honorable Artillery Company in 1638(he was granted 200 acres of land in the town of Sudbury for his service in the Pequod Wars(fn4,p117)*, Selectman in Watertown from 1635 to 1642, 1644 and a Representative from 1637 to 1642 and 1645. In 1636, as a Commander of one of the infantry companies he battled with the Pequod Indians at Black Island in revenge of the murder of Mr. John **Oldham**(fn1,p306,307). In 1634, during one of the bleakest winters the colonists had seen rations came up short. Capt Jennison sailed to Virginia returning to Boston with 5000 bushels of corn becoming a local hero(fn2, p.58). In 1645, he sold his home to Rev. John Knowles and sailed to Virginia before heading home to England in 1648(fn1, p.215).

On April 8, 1657, Captain William Jamison of Colchester, Old England, by his brother, Robert Jamison, conveyed to Edmund Rice 200 acres*, granted to him in 1638. This land is now located on the east side of Cochituate Lake in the town of Cochituate on the southwest side of Nonesuch Pond approximately ten miles from the lands he also owned in Watertown.

He never married and had no children.

He married (1) Elizabeth Kilbourne between 1636-1637 in Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA^{9, 18}. She was born in 1608 in Colchester, Essex, England^{9, 19}. She died on Oct/10/1638 in Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA (Age: 30^{18-19, 29}). He married (2) Grace Jossalyn about 1639 in Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA^{9, 16}. She was born in 1615. She died on Nov/26/1686 in Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA^{9, 28}.
 - iii. ELIZABETH JENISON³⁰ was born in 1612. She married Henry **Bowes** on May/08/1649 in Saint Nicholas Parish, Newcastle Upon Tyne, Northumberland, England³⁰.



3. **ROBERT**³ **JENNISON** (Robert² Jenison, Sir Ralph¹)^{9, 16-28} was born in 1615 in Colchester, Essex, England²⁶. He died on Jul/04/1690 in Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA^{9, 16, 18, 27}. He married (1) **Elizabeth Kilbourne** between 1636-1637 in Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA^{9, 18}. She was born in 1608 in Colchester, Essex, England^{9, 19}. She died on Oct/10/1638 in Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA (Age: 30^{18-19, 29}). He married (2) **Grace Jossalyn** about 1639 in Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA^{9, 16}. She was born in 1615. She died on Nov/26/1686 in Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA^{9, 28}. Robert Jennison^{9, 16-28} arrived in Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA in 1631²². His estate was probated in 1690 in Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA²⁶.

Notes for Robert Jennison:

This family from Colchester, England has always spelt the name Jenison or Jennison, however, since coming to the Colonies the surname has, as usual, seen a number of misspellings which has led to confusion to a number of researchers. Many have incorrectly labeled them Jamison and Jameson and have added these people to their lineages failing to realize the differences this makes to their tree.

The younger brother of William Jenison and his sister, Elizabeth, he appears as early as 1630-31 in Charlestown and in Watertown as early as July 25th, 1636 when he was allotted in the Fifth Division, Lot #8 of 20 acres. June 26th of 1637, Mr. Jenison received a two acre lot #73 in the Remote or Westpine section of town. In April of 1637(fn1,p307), his first daughter, Elizabeth was born. Unlike William he was not guite the wanderlust and choose to settle and have a family. On November 27th, 1639, the town was not quite the wanderlust and choose to settle and have a family. On November 27th, 1639, the town ordered that the road laid out from Robert Jennison's and between the lots of John Bernard and Jeremiah Norcrosse with a half-acre parcel adjoining the river for a landing of Goods shall remain to the town's use forever(fn3,p5). He was admitted a Freeman in May of 1645(fn1,Ibid). "At ameting of the Select men the 8/4/1654 Robert Genefon and John Knap Complaining that Robert **Daniell** that hee Did not fence his prortion within their feild."(fn3,p37). Robert Jenison purchased and was given land by the Charles River by his brother, William, who then sailed on to Virginia, Bermuda and eventually to England where he died. Robert and his son, Samuel, Jennison used the land for agriculture, farming and landing of commodities which they sold to the locals. Samuel Jennison Jr. extended this by leasing the lands from the town in May of 1728 for £9 annually for four years in the Charles River(fn2,ps164,165).

His will was written September 15, 1688 and probated October 7, 1690(*fn1*, *Ibid*). He mentions daughter, Michal **Warren**, son-in-law, George **Reed**, son, Samuel, and grandsons, William and Robert Jenison.

George Read^{31, 33-34, 37} arrived in Massachusetts, USA in 1635 (Age: 6³⁷). His estate was probated in 1706 in Woburn, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA³⁸. Source mentions marriage in Woburn, Ma.

Samuel: His estate was probated on Oct/20/1701 in Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, USA⁶².

Notes for Samuel Jenison II:

Samuel Jennison acquired considerable land in Watertown where he was born. In 1672(**fn1**-p371) appointed "hog reeves" and it goes without saying a strong and leading church member of the community. He was admitted Freeman October 11, 1682, served various posts in town from perambulator from 1680 to 1693, tithingman, '82-83, town clerk, 1691, Moderator in 1692, and Constable from 1693-95. As a deputy he advocated for Shubael Child who was temporarily declared insane and thrown into prison and was crippled completely when his feet froze in 1694.

He made his will in November of 1700 and proved in October of 1701. His wife, Judith, received the homestead and lands along with £60. His son, Samuel, received 1 acre of meadowland; son, William, of Sudbury, received 40 acres; and Robert the homestead and lands after her death;

Notes for Mary Vibert:

Unless Mrs. Mary Jennison was married previous to William Jennison, then she was probably related to the Viberts in Boston, MA. The Viberts/Veberts/Vibburts, etc. are a people native to London, England. Some may have been Huguenots, possibly French in origin, having removed to England at an earlier time before sailing across the Atlantic to Canada and the American colonies. A birth record for her daughter, Sarah Gummer Jennison, may be named after a relative or possibly a younger sister, Sarah, who married April 3, 1793, Boston, James Gummer.

One such group, led by John and his wife, Joanne Williams Vibert, settled on Naushon Island, an island situated just north of Martha's Vineyard. This family then moved to Montville, New London, Connecticut and from there dispersed toward northern New England and New York. Smaller groups landed in Boston, MA. One of these, was Phillip Vibert and his wife, Jane, who he married in 1720. Phillip Vibert was born about 1700 and died in Boston in August of 1777. The couple had several children: Isaac, 1727-1777, a shipwright in Boston; Phillip Jr., b. 1722; a child, not named born and died in 1721; Thomas, b. 1728, married first, 1752, Boston, Mary Mallett and second, 1758, Mary Watson; Mary, b. 1724, Boston; another Mary, b. in Boston; and finally, Jane Vibert who married 1747, Boston, to Matthew Kennedy. Matthew Vibert, b.c. 1685 appears in Boston just prior to 1705, when he is listed marrying Sarah Fare, b.c. 1687. Only one child is known to have been born in Boston, Sarah, born 1706 and in 1730, married there to George Newell. Capt. Aaron Vibert had sailed down from Canada on the sloop, Susannah, in 1764 to Boston. Two years later, his wife, Mrs. Vibert, arrived in Boston. A John Veber/Vibert came to Boston, early, and settled in Charlemont, Franklin co., MA, though this man may be related to the New London Connecticut family.
